GENERAL

The Clubhouse facilities, Dining Room, Lounge, Grille, Activity Center and Clubhouse Swimming Pool are available to all Homeowners, Equity, Golf, Tennis Members and Renters of Sunrise Country Club.

Use of the Golf Course, Tennis Courts and the Fitness Center is by Membership only. Annual, monthly and weekly memberships are available to all Homeowners, Equity Members and renters of the Club. Fitness Membership is available daily, weekly, monthly or annually. Annual Golf & Tennis Memberships are available to Non-Homeowners.

All Members' rights to playing privileges are subject to prepayment of non-transferable and non-refundable annual, monthly or weekly dues.

An Equity Member or Social Member's spouse and children under the age of twenty-one (21) shall be included in the purchase of a two player annual, monthly or weekly membership.

Any person who is a Member of a Golf or Tennis Club is entitled to play Golf and/or Tennis at Sunrise Country club pursuant to the terms of reciprocal play. Each reciprocal guest is limited to playing four times a year. Reciprocity shall not be granted to an Equity Member, Social Member or Renter.

EQUITY MEMBERS

An Equity Member (Homeowner or Non-Homeowner) is an owner of the Club and as such enjoys the following rights and privileges:

The Equity Member and his/her family may play Golf and/or Tennis by purchasing a weekly, monthly or annual playing membership at the discounted equity rate.

A renter of an Equity Member may play Golf and/or Tennis by purchasing a weekly, monthly or annual playing membership at the equity rate as long as the membership term does not exceed the term of the lease.

An Equity Member receives a discount on food purchased in the Dining Room, the Grille and soft goods merchandise in the Golf Pro Shop. The amount of the discount may be changed from time to time at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

All Equity members, whether they exercise their playing privileges or not, are responsible for spending the established minimum for food in the Clubs facilities each season (September through July).

SOCIAL MEMBERS

A Social Homeowner Member is a Member who does not own Equity in the Club and as such enjoys the following rights and privileges:

Full club and charging privileges in the clubhouse dining room, lounge and Grille.

They may play Golf and/or Tennis weekly, monthly or annually by purchasing a membership at the current non-equity rate.

A Social Non-Homeowner Member is a member who does not own an Equity or Sunrise Condominium but still enjoys full club and charging privileges in the clubhouse, dining room,

lounge and grille. A Non homeowner member may purchase an Annual Golf and or Tennis Membership at the non-equity rate.

All Social Members (Homeowner or Non-Homeowner) who purchase an annual Golf Membership are responsible for spending the current set minimum for food in the Club facilities each season (September through July).

GUESTS

MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUESTS' CONDUCT, OBLIGATIONS AND ADHERANCE TO THE CLUB'S DRESS CODE INCLUSIVE OF THE GOLF COURSE, TENNIS COURTS, FITNESS/ACTIVITY CENTER, GRILLE AND CLUBHOUSE.

Equity and Social Members, who have exercised their playing privileges, may invite guests to play Golf or Tennis, at the current guest rates.

Golf and Tennis guests must be registered at the Club Pro Shops prior to play. Good conduct shall prevail at all times and shall include sportsmanship and respect for the rights and welfare of others. *GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CLUB MEMBER UNLESS PREARRANGED WITH THE CLUB PRO SHOPS.* Guest fees must be paid by the sponsoring Member or his guest prior to play.

Dining room guest privileges are available to guests accompanied by the member. Charge cards will be accepted from the guests only when accompanied by the member. *PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MADE WITH DINING ROOM IF UNACCOMPANED BY MEMBER.* .

RENTERS

Renting a condominium at Sunrise Country Club gives you full club privileges in the Dining Room, Lounge and Grille. *Credit cards and cash are not accepted in the dining room.* Renters are asked to set up charge privileges in the Administration Office prior to using the Dining Room or Lounge. A \$50.00 deposit is required to activate your account. All personal charges will be made against this deposit and a statement will be mailed to you each month. Any unused funds will be refunded when the account is closed. Cash is accepted in the grille

The account number given to you may be used for all services at the Country Club.

A renter of a Homeowner Social Member may play Golf and/or Tennis, by purchasing, a weekly, monthly, or annual membership at the non-equity rate as long as the term of membership does not exceed the term of the rental agreement. Renters who purchase weekly, monthly or annual Golf and/or Tennis Memberships are considered Members for the duration of their membership. *RENTERS MAY NOT PLAY AS A GUEST OF A MEMBER OR ON A RECIPROCAL BASIS.*

IT IS THE HOMEOWNERS RESPONSIBILITY TO ADVISE THE RENTER OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS AND DRESS CODE PERTAINING TO THE USE OF THE CLUBS FACILITIES INCLUSIVE OF THE GOLF COURSE, TENNIS COURTS, FITNESS/ACTIVITY CENTER, GRILLE AND CLUBHOUSE.

DRESS CODE

SUNRISE COUNTRY CLUB IS A SPECIAL PLACE. THE BOARD RECOGNIZES THAT WE ARE A FAMILY CLUB, ORIENTED TO THE RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES WE OFFER. WHILE WE ACKNOWLEDGE THE CONTINUING TREND TOWARD CASUAL ATTIRE IN BOTH BUSINESS AND LEISURE, THE HOUSE COMMITTEE FEELS IT IS NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH SOME STANDARDS OF DRESS TO ACCOMMODATE THE PREFERENCE OF THE MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERSHIP.

THE HOST/HOYESS ON DUTY WILL HAVE THE FINAL AUTHORITY FOR THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE DRESS. DRESS AND CONDUCT OF CHILDREN SHALL AT ALL TIMES, BE SIMILARLY SUITABLE TO THE DECORUM AND DRESS REQUIRED OF ADULTS.

BEFORE 5:30 P.M. TUESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY

APPROPRIATE GOLF AND TENNIS ATTIRE, CASUAL SLACKS, WARM-UP SUITS, JEANS, DRESS DENIMS AND DENIM FABRIC CLOTHING

AFTER 5:30 P.M. TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY

APPROPRIATE GOLF AND TENNIS ATTIRE
NO JEANS OR DENIM FABRIC CLOTHING

AFTER 5:30 P.M. FRIDAY AND SATURDAY

NO SHORTS, JEANS, DRESS JEANS OR DENIM FABRIC CLOTHING

LADIES: BLOUSES, SWEATERS, DRESSES, SKIRTS AND SLACKS

MEN: CASUAL SLACKS, MOCK TURTLE NECK SHIRTS WITH A 1-1/2" BANDED NECK, SHIRTS WITH SLEEVES AND COLLAR

II. BAR

TUESDAY THROUGH SUNDAY

APPROPRIATE GOLF AND TENNIS ATTIRE, CASUAL SLACKS, WARM-UP SUITS, JEANS, DRESS DENIMS AND DENIM FABRIC CLOTHING

CLOTHING NOT APPROVED FOR THE CLUBHOUSE DINING ROOM OR BAR:

LADIES

STRAPLESS TOPS AND BARE MIDRIFTS, JOGGING SHORTS, CUT OFFS, SWIM SUITS AND FLIP FLOPS

MEN:

HATS, SWIM SUITS, CUT OFFS, JOGGING SHORTS, AND FLIP FLOPS

III. GRILLE

SWIMSUIT COVER-UPS AND FOOT WEAR MUST BE WORN WHEN ORDERING AND EATING IN THE GRILLE AND GRILLE OUTSIDE EATING AREA

IV. GOLF COURSE

THE GOLF PROFESSIONAL SHALL HAVE THE FINAL AUTHORITY AS TO THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE GOLFING ATTIRE.

ONLY APPROVED SOFTSPIKED OR SPIKELESS SHOES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE

SKIRTS AND SHORTS ARE ALLOWED WITH A MAXIMUM OF FOUR (4) INCHES FROM THE TOP OF KNEE TO THE BOTTOM OF THE GARMENT

SHIRTS WITH COLLARS AND SLEEVES AND MOCK TURTLE NECK SHIRTS WITH 1-1/2" BANDED NECK ARE ALLOWED

ALL SHIRTS EXCEPT BANDED WAIST SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN

CLOTHING NOT APPROVED FOR THE GOLF COURSE

LADIES:

STRAPLESS TOPS, HALTER TOPS AND TOPS WITH LESS THAN 1-1/2 INCH STRAPS, BARE MIDRIFTS, CUT-OFFS, TENNIS SHORTS, JOGGING SHORTS, JEANS AND DENIM FABRIC CLOTHING

MEN:

CUT-OFFS, TENNIS SHORTS, JOGGING SHORTS, JEANS, DENIM-FABRIC CLOTHING AND T- SHIRTS

V. TENNIS COURTS

THE TENNIS DIRECTOR SHALL HAVE THE FINAL AUTHORITY AS TO THE APPROPRIATENESS OF THE TENNIS ATTIRE

TENNIS PLAYERS, INCLUDING CHILDREN, ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR ACCEPTABLE TENNIS WEAR AND SHOES

SHIRTS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

CLOTHING NOT APPROVED FOR THE TENNIS COURTS
CUT-OFFS, JEANS, SWIM SUITS, GYM SHORTS OR JOGGING SHORTS

DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

GOLF COURSE RULES

Keep pace of play moving in an orderly fashion. We allow a group to play 18 holes in a maximum time of 3 hrs. 15 min. The goal is to play 10 min. per hole.

Board of Directors Policy: If a group falls one full hole behind the group in front of them and they are not on pace to finish in 3 hours 15 minutes, the Player Assistant shall inform them that they are behind. If the group falls two or more holes behind, the Player Assistant shall inform the Pro Shop and a Pro will then talk to the group. At the Pro's discretion, the group may be told to finish the current hole and then move to their proper position on the course.

1. All Members and their guests should register for play 15 minutes prior to going on the course and observe any instructions given by the Golf Professional or his Assistants. Starting play or practicing mid-course is not permitted.
2. The golf course will be open daily. Players must check with the golf pro shop for specific hours. Starting times are available to Equity Members and Associate Members with annual Golf Playing memberships up to three (3) days in advance. Starting times are available to all other eligible golfers one (1) day in advance.
3. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE GOLF COURSE. Those children between six (6) and sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult.
4. Pets are not permitted on the golf course.
5. Fivesomes, at the discretion of the Golf Professional, are allowed to play from June 1 until the end of summer. Fivesomes are limited to three carts. Tournaments that require more than foursomes are permitted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
6. Players are not to leave the 10th tee position when it will disrupt the continuity of play. Such players will be rescheduled for play at the first available time. Players playing an eighteen hole round have priority to the 10th tee.
7. For the pleasure of every golfer, the course should be kept in good condition. Divots should be repaired by the use of sand and seed provided by the Pro Shop. BALLMARKS ON THE GREENS SHOULD BE REPAIRED. Bunkers should be raked before leaving the hole and the rake placed well inside the bunker. Trash receptacles should be utilized.
8. In the absence of special rules, no activity on the golf course, except golf activities, is permitted by anyone at anytime. No one shall be allowed on the golf course except those participating in golf activity, i.e. players, spectators.
9. Spectators will not stand or walk on tees, greens or in any bunkers. All spectators on the golf course shall conduct themselves with proper regard to safety and etiquette.

10. All players are to follow the instructions of the PLAYER ASSISTANCE PERSONNEL.
11. All players shall be governed by the U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf except as modified by local rules.
12. Where applicable, the golf course rules apply to the practice putting greens and the driving range.
13. Bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are not permitted around the Golf Pro Shop, cart areas or putting greens.

CARTS

1. DO NOT PARK GOLF CARTS IN FRONT OF THE TENNIS PRO SHOP OR THE GRILLE.

2. In the interest of minimizing golf cart damage to the golf course, the maximum number of carts allowed on the golf course is as follows:

One Player	One Cart
Two Players	One Cart
Three Players	Two Carts
Four Players	Two Carts
Five Players	Three Carts

3. When one player operating a cart joins three players operating two carts, the group is responsible for parking the third cart at their earliest opportunity.

4. Members may own and use their own golf cart provided the annual cart license fee has been paid, otherwise a riders fee will be charged each time cart is taken on the course. All licensed carts must display the owner's lot number and annual cart fee decal. The lot number will be installed by the Golf Pro Shop.

5. All power carts must be electrically powered. GOLF CARTS, ELECTRIC WALKING CARTS AND PULL CARTS SHOULD NEVER BE DRIVEN OR TAKEN ON THE TEE BOXES; OR TAKEN OR DRIVEN CLOSER THAN THIRTY (30) FEET TO THE GREENS. CART PATHS ARE BESIDE ALL TEES AND GREENS. PLEASE USE THEM.

NEVER DRIVE INSIDE OF GROUND ROPES OR IN FRONT OF GREENS ON PAR 4 HOLES. All walkers are required to carry an adequate supply of sand and seed to repair divots. Follow all signs. Roped areas are not to be entered.

6. GOLF CARTS SHALL FOLLOW THE 90 DEGREE RULE ON ALL PAR 4 HOLES. TRAVEL IN THE ROUGH UNTIL YOU'RE EVEN WITH YOUR BALL, AND THEN TURN 90 DEGREES TO THE BALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED BY THE PRO SHOP. AFTER YOUR SHOT, RETURN TO THE ROUGH. Avoid wet and worn spots to best preserve the turf.

7. ON PAR 3 HOLES, GOLF CARTS WILL REMAIN ON THE CARTPATHS AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE KEEP ALL FOUR WHEELS ON THE CART PATHS. Exception June 1 to October 1st.

8. On all shotgun starts, players proceeding to their starting tees or returning at the end of play are to use ONLY streets and cart paths. The only exceptions are: going to the 4th tee and returning from the 3rd green use the 2nd hole cart path and the 3rd

hole rough. AND for going to the 5th tee and returning from the 4th green, use the 6th hole cart path and 5th hole rough. DO NOT drive between condominium buildings.

9. Members who are physically impaired will be issued flags which will allow them to drive or ride on par 3 fairways, using the 90-degree rule, but not closer than 30 feet to greens. Flags will be authorized and issued by the administration office upon presentation of DMV handicap parking permit or other proof of impairment.

The approved flag privilege will be valid for the period of the impairment and renewable on an annual basis. Able bodied drivers or riders with the physically impaired player shall comply with the regular rules of cart operation when playing their game.

10. NO PERSON UNDER SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF AGE MAY OPERATE A GOLF CART AT ANY TIME. GOLF CART OPERATORS MUST HAVE A QUALIFIED DRIVER LICENSE.

11. DO NOT SPIN WHEELS. Start slowly and with care. Where possible avoid other cart tracks and avoid heavily irrigated areas.

12. Each player must have a set of clubs and bag.

13. Players who ride must ride in an approved cart. Players may walk at any time the course is open. Speed of play will be monitored by the Player Assistant and Pro Staff.

14. Members and guests shall be held fully responsible for any or all damages that are caused by the use of their carts.

15. IMPORTANT: Traffic across frozen grass results in permanent damage. During cold and other severe climatic conditions, such as flooding, players with carts and pedestrians must check with the Golf Pro Shop prior to entering the golf course.

16. All members must have an established handicap to participate in any CLUB competition.

17. Seasonal rules may be allowed. Notification of such shall be posted in and at the entrance to the Pro Shop. Said rules shall be approved by the Clubs General Manager, Golf Professional and Golf Course Superintendent.

TENNIS COURT RULES

1. All members and their guests are required to register for play at the Tennis Shop prior to going to the courts and to observe all instructions given by the Tennis Director or staff.

2. Good conduct shall prevail at all times and shall include a maximum of sportsmanship and respect for the rights and welfare of others.

3. Food and drink are not allowed on the tennis courts. Smoking is not allowed on the courts. Animals, roller skates, skate boards, roller blades or any wheeled vehicles are not allowed on the tennis courts, the Tennis Shop area and the walkways between and around the tennis courts.

4. As a courtesy to our Tennis Professional, instruction of any kind is not allowed by visiting instructors or professionals.

5. The tennis courts will be open for play daily during daylight hours. Courts are available for night play until 10 p.m.
6. Tennis instructions are available at the Tennis Pro Shop from tennis professionals.
7. Arrangements may be made through the Tennis Pro Shop for lessons and use of ball machines.
8. The Tennis Pro Shop is open 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily, from October 1st to June 1st. Summer hours will be posted prior to June 1st.

TENNIS COURT RESERVATIONS

Court reservations may be made for the following week beginning on Saturday or Sunday by signing up or calling the Tennis Pro Shop. Other requests for reservations may be made from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily.

Court time will be no more than an hour and one-half unless otherwise authorized by the Tennis Director or Staff.

CLUBHOUSE SWIMMING POOL

Appropriate bathing attire is requested at all times in the pool area.

Observe all posted rules. There is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. Swim at your own risk. CHILDREN under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (a person 18 years or older).

POOL HOURS are 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Please, respect the privacy of persons who reside in close proximity to the pool. Keep RADIOS low for personal use. REMOVE SUNTAN LOTIONS AND OILS before entering pool. Soaps or detergents are not allowed in the pool. These materials clog filters and cause high pool maintenance costs.

Pool furniture may not be reserved and must not be removed from the immediate pool deck.

NO GLASS containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area at any time.

PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE POOL AREA AT ANYTIME.

No running, pushing, wrestling or other horseplay is permitted.

No golf carts, bicycles or other wheeled vehicles are permitted on the pool deck or adjacent thereto.

TRASH AND CIGARETTE BUTTS ARE TO BE PLACED IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS.

Swimmers have priority over pool floats, air mattresses and similar devices when there is a high concentration of swimmers in the pool.

POOL EQUIPMENT AND CONTROLS MUST NOT BE TAMPERED WITH UNDER ANY CONDITIONS.

ACTIVITY CENTER
FITNESS CENTER

The Activity Center is for the use of all Members of Sunrise Country Club.

The FITNESS CENTER is open to all members who have paid their Membership fee. All dues are non-transferable and non-refundable. No person(s) under 18 years of age is permitted to use the FITNESS CENTER.

Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn in the FITNESS CENTER at all times.

The ACTIVITY/FITNESS Center is open from 6:00 am until 10.00 pm seven (7) days a week, twelve (12) months a year.

Pets are not allowed in the ACTIVITY/FITNESS Center at any time

SMOKING POLICY

Sunrise Country Club is a NON-SMOKING facility.

CELL PHONE POLICY
CLUBHOUSE

No cell phones may be used in the Clubhouse Building.

ACTIVITY/FITNESS CENTER

No cell phones may be used inside the Activity/Fitness Center.

GOLF COURSE

Cell phones on the Golf Course must be turned off;
Only outgoing calls may be made.
