TREE REMOVAL

- 1. Timely tree removal is an integral part of the overall landscape management of the HOA. Trees will be considered for removal in accordance with the following criteria (listed in priority order).**
 - 1. Dead trees**
 - 2. Hazardous trees - decay, excessive lean, etc.**
 - 3. Trees causing unacceptable structural damage**
 - 4. Overcrowded trees adversely affecting other trees or landscape**
 - 5 Trees will be considered for removal for personal reasons such as aesthetically displeasing trees, view, leaf or fruit drop, sun, shade, tree variety, etc. Trees have been planted to protect the condo(s) from errant golf balls. A tree that is requested for removal, not meeting the tree removal guidelines, will be at the expense of the homeowner as well as the possible replacement. The Landscape & Gardening Committee must first approve the removal of these trees. Our Landscape Contractor will handle all tree removals and replacements.**
