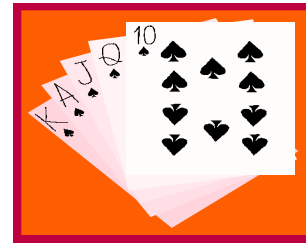


JUST FOR BRIDGE PLAYERS
