VACANT HOME FORM

If your home is to be vacant for a period of time, a form is available in the SCC HOA office to put on file. The Guard service gives extra attention to all units on this list.

HOA OFFICE KEY LOCKER

A Key Locker is kept in the Association office so that an extra key can be safely stored for use in an emergency. There have been numerous occasions where an emergency situation has occurred such as someone falling and needs help. We have to be able to get in without breaking a window or door to help. Sometimes it is something as simple as you accidentally lock yourself out.

In order to obtain this key, proper identification and/or a written request signed by the homeowner must be presented to the Administrative staff.

HEALTH MONITORING PROGRAM

The Sunrise HOA Health Monitoring Program[®] provides a daily contact service for those residents who aren't in touch regularly with friends, neighbors or family members. This service is also for those who may have health problems.

Those that choose to enroll will be asked to phone the Country Club Gate at 760-328-7277 every day prior to 1:00 p.m. If contact is NOT made, a gate or patrol officer will telephone or make a personal visit to the homeowner's residence. If there is no response, the officer will contact designated relatives or friends. As a last resort the Riverside County Sheriff's Office will be asked to investigate.

Enrollees will be asked to provide keys to their units and emergency contact names via an enrollment form. For information, please contact the SCC Administration office at 760-328-6045.
